Sub: **Status in respect of compliance OERC RCPO Regulations by Obligated Entities.**

Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, it is to intimate you that Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission has framed OERC (Renewable and Co-generation Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulation, 2010, wherein, it has been specified that, the State Agency, OREDA is required to submit quarterly status in respect of Compliance of Obligation by the Obligated Entities to the Commission and to suggest appropriate action, if required, for compliance of such Obligation.

It appears from the status report submitted by OREDA that the reports are incomplete and apparently no action has been suggested and or taken by OREDA on non-compliance of obligation by the obligated entities. Further, as per Regulation 7(1), if the Obligated Entities do not fulfill their RPO, they are required to deposit the required shortfall into separate designated funds on the basis of Commission's directions.

Further, in the matter of RPO compliance, the MD & CEO, PXIL vide the letter under reference has requested you to display the information of obligated entities on RPO targets vis-à-vis their compliance on your website.

In view of the above, I am directed to request you to take necessary action to display the information of obligated entities on RPO targets vis-à-vis their compliance on your website and furnish the following necessary details on or before 14.08.2014, so as to enable the Commission to pass appropriate directions.

- The list of Obligated Entities in Odisha and the compliance of RCPO on the part of each such entity from the FY 2011-12 to 2013-14 by way of the actual sourcing or through purchase of Renewable Energy Certificates including quantum of default for evaluating compliance by the obligated entities.
- Action taken by OREDA for non-compliance of the obligation by obligated entities.
