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### Interpretation

In the Bidding Document, except where the context requires otherwise:

- IV. "written" or "in writing" means hand-written, type-written, printed, or electronically made, and resulting in a permanent record; and
- V. The marginal words and other headings shall not be taken into consideration in the interpretation of these conditions.
- VI. An applicable law shall be construed as reference to such applicable law including its amendments or re-enactments from time to time.
- VII. A time of day shall save as otherwise provided in any agreement or document be construed as a reference to Indian Standard Time.
- VIII. Different parts of this contract are to be taken as mutually explanatory and supplementary to each other and if there is any differentiation between or among the parts of this contract, they shall be interpreted in a harmonious manner so as to give effect to each part.
- IX. The table of contents and any headings or sub-headings in the contract has been inserted for case of reference only & shall not affect the interpretation of this agreement

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## 1. Instruction to Bidders (ITB)

Section 1 (ITB)providesageneral overview and contents of RFP along with the preparation, submission, opening, evaluation, comparison of Bids, issuance of letter of intent, and execution of Power Purchase Agreement (TPA), etc. Section 1 (ITB) shall be read in conjunction with Section 2 (BDS) and other provisions listed therein, shall be a complete document expressing all terms and conditions. In case of any interpretation issues, Section 2 (BDS), including any associated Addendum, Corrigendum, and Clarification, will supersede Section 1 (ITB).

### 1.1. General

#### 1.1.1. Scope of RFP

- 1.1.1.1. In connection with the NIT, OREDA issues this RFPcontaining all the terms and conditions mentioned herein.
- 1.1.1.2. The RFP, along with the NIT andany Addendum, Corrigendum, and Clarification,to be issued from time to time,shall be collectively termed as the Bidding Document. In addition, OREDA has enclosed the Tripartite Agreement (TPA) that forms an integral part of this RFP. Such a Bidding Document shall be published on the E-procurement Website. Such a Bidding Document shall also be uploaded on OREDA Website, but only for viewing purposes.
- 1.1.1.3. The detailed SOW, including the associated NIT no., RFPNo. and other details, are specified in Section 2 (BDS).

#### 1.1.2. Integrity Violation

- 1.1.2.1. The Bidder observes the highest standard of ethics all the time.
- 1.1.2.2. OREDA defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:
  - a) "Corrupt Practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another Party;
  - b) "Fraudulent Practice" means any act or omission including a misrepresentation that knowingly or recklessly misleads or attempts to mislead a Party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
  - c) "Coercive Practice" means impairing or harming or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any Party or the property of a Party to influence improperly the actions of the otherParty;
  - d) "Collusive Practice" means an arrangement between two or more Parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing the actions of other Party improperly;
  - e) "Obstructive Practice" means
    - i. deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering, or concealing of evidence material to OREDA's investigation;
    - ii. making false statements to investigators to materially impede OREDA's investigation;
    - iii. failing to comply with requests to provide information, documents, or records in connection with OREDA's investigation;
    - iv. threatening, harassing, or intimidating any Party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or
    - v. materially impeding OREDA's contractual rights of audit or access to information;

- f) "Integrity Violation" is an act which violates OREDA'spolicies, including (a) to (e) given above in the ITB Clause 1.1.2.2and the following abuse, conflict of interest, retaliation against whistleblowers or witnesses, and other violations of OREDA'spolicies, including failure to adhere to the highest ethical standard.
- 1.1.2.3. OREDA will reject a Bid if it determines that the Bidder has, directly or indirectly through an agent, engaged in Integrity Violation including but limited to any Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice, Collusive Practice, andObstructive Practice;
- 1.1.2.4. OREDA will impose remedial actions on any Bidder or an individual, at any time, in accordance with itspoliciesand guidelines (both as amended from time to time), including declaring ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to participate in OREDAmanaged, -administered, or -supported activities or to benefit from an OREDA-managed, administered, or -supported, financially or otherwise, if it at any time determines that the Bidder or individual has, directly or through an agent, engaged in Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice, Collusive Practice, Obstructive Practice or Integrity Violation; and
- 1.1.2.5. OREDA will have the right to inspect the accounts, records, other documents, etc.,of the Bidders and relating to the Bid submission and to have them audited at any point in time.

### 1.2. Contents of the RFP

#### 1.2.1. Sections of the RFP

- 1.2.1.1. The RFP consists of the following Sections as indicated below and should be read in conjunction with the NIT and any Addendum, Corrigendum and Clarification.

- 1.2.1.2. OREDA is not responsible for the completeness of the Bidding Document if they were not obtained directly from the E-procurement Website.
- 1.2.1.3. The Bidder is expected to examine the complete Bidding Document. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding Document may result in the rejection of the Bid.

#### 1.2.2. Clarification on RFP, Site Visit, and Pre-Bid Meeting

- 1.2.2.1. A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification on theRFP shall contact at OREDA's Office Addressor writeto OREDA's Official Email Id,beforethe pre-bid meeting, in accordance with ITB Clause 1.2.2.2. The queries shall be raised as per the format provided in Annexure Clause5.3.
- 1.2.2.2. The pre-bid meeting shall be conducted in the manner specified in Section 2 (BDS). The Bidder's designated representative may attend the pre-bid meeting. The purpose of the pre-bid meeting is to clarify issues and prepare Clarification against the queries received from the Bidders on any matter that may be raised at that stage. OREDA may respond to any query for providing Clarification in writing, provided that such queries are received as per the timelines given in the NIT and any Corrigendum.

- 1.2.2.3. The Clarification against the queries raised, without identifying the source of the prospective Bidder, may be uploaded on the E-procurement Website and OREDA Website. Any modification to the RFPshall be made by OREDA exclusively through the issue of an Addendum.
- 1.2.2.4. Non-attendance at the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for the disqualification of a Bidder.
- 1.2.2.5. The Bidder is advised to find their own land, nearest substation of Discom for evacuation and its surroundings to obtain all information necessary for the preparation of the Bids at their end.
- 1.2.2.6. The Bidder and any of its personnel and/ or agents visiting Project Site for such visit if applicable, only upon the express condition that the Bidder, its personnel, and/ or agents will release and indemnify OREDA and its personnel, agents,etc. from and against any liability in respect thereof, and the Bidder shall be responsible for any death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property, and any other loss, damage, costs,expenses, etc. incurred as a result of the inspection during the visit to the ProjectSite.

#### 1.2.3. Addendum, Corrigendum, and Clarification to the RFP

- 1.2.3.1. At any time, prior to the deadline for submission of Bids, OREDA may issue an Addendum, Corrigendum, and Clarification.
- 1.2.3.2. OREDA may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids by issuing a Corrigendum to give prospective Bidders reasonable time in preparing their Bids. At any point in time, the latest Corrigendum will supersede the Schedule of Events mentioned in the NIT or any previously issued Corrigendum.
- 1.2.3.3. OREDA may, at its discretion, modify or change any specific provisions of terms and conditions of the RFP or any Addendum issued previously by issuing an Addendum for such specific provisions. At any point in time, the provisions provided against a specific Clause in the latest Addendum shall supersede such provisions already provided in the RFP or any previously issued Addendum.

### 1.3. Preparation of Bids

#### 1.3.1. Cost for preparation of Bid

1.3.1.1. The Bidder shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Bid, and OREDA shall in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

#### 1.3.2. Language of Bid

- 1.3.2.1. The Bid and all correspondence and documents for any communications exchanged by the Bidder and OREDA shall be written in the English language only.
- 1.3.2.2. Any supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Bid may be submitted in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the English language only, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, such English translation shall govern. In case of any misrepresentations in the English language vis-à-vis another language, OREDA, at its discretion, can reject the Bid submitted by the Bidder on the ground of misrepresentation of the information.

#### 1.3.3. Documents comprising the Bid

1.3.3.1. The Bid shall comprise the Technical Bid and Price Bid.The Technical Bid and Price Bid shall be submitted online pursuant to ITB Clause 1.3.3.2 and ITB Clause 1.3.3.4, respectively, as per all the Bidding Document's terms and conditions. - 1.3.8.2. The original documents of the Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by the Authorized Signatory supported by the seal of the Bidder. - 1.4.2.2. OREDA may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids through the publication of a Corrigendum in accordance with ITB Clause1.2.3.2, in which case all rights and obligations of OREDA and Bidders previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

#### 1.4.3. Late Bids

1.4.3.1. OREDA shall not consider any Bid that arrives after the deadline for submission of Bids, in accordance with ITB Clause1.4.2. Any Bid (either online or offline) received by OREDA after the deadline for submission of Bids shall be declared as alate Bid. Such late Bids shall be liable for rejectiononline, and the onlinecopy of the Bid uploaded on the E-procurement Website shall be sent unopened to "Archive" and shall not be considered at all any further for evaluation. In such a case, thehardcopies in the original form shall be returned unopened to the Bidder.

#### 1.4.4. Withdrawal, Substitution, and Modification of Bids

- 1.4.4.1. A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its Technical Bid or Price Bid after it has been submitted as per the procedure mentioned in the E-procurement Website and the instructions mentioned in ITB Clause 1.4.1.1.
- 1.4.4.2. No Bid may be withdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of Bid and the expiration of Bid validity period specified by the Bidder on the Covering Letters of Technical Bid and Price Bid or any extension thereof as per the terms of Bidding Document.
- 1.4.4.3. Bidder may modify or withdraw their Bids through the relevant provisions on the Eprocurement Website until the last date for submission of Bid as per the timelines mentioned in the NIT or any Corrigendum.
- 1.4.4.4. The Bidders may modify, resubmit, or withdraw their Bids as per the provisions given on the E-procurement Website.
- 1.4.4.5. In the case of original hardcopies of the Bidder, such Bids will be considered based on the latest submission made by the Bidder. In such a case, any previous original hardcopies shall be returned unopened to the Bidder.

#### 1.4.5. Acceptance/ rejection of the Bids

1.4.5.1. The Bids submitted by the Bidders shall be liable for rejection in case

- a) Any incomplete or non-submission of any mandatory Bid Form or document mentioned under online or hardcopy submission of Technical Bid pursuant to ITB Clause 1.3.3.2 and ITB Clause 1.3.3.3.
- b) Any incomplete or non-submission of any mandatory Bid Form or document mentioned under the online submission of Price Bid pursuant toITB Clause 1.3.3.4.
- c) Late Bids received as per ITB Clause 1.4.3.
- d) Canvassing in any manner shall not be entertained and will be viewed seriously and shall be liable for rejection.
- e) The Bids are found non-responsive pursuant to all the relevant clauses in the Bidding Document.

#### 1.4.6. Technical Bid Opening

#### 1.4.6.1. Technical Bid (Online and hardcopies)

#### a) Online Technical Bid:

i. OREDA shall open the online Technical Bids on the E-procurement Website as per the timelines mentioned in the NIT or any Corrigendum.

#### b) Hardcopies of Technical Bid:

### 1.5. Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

#### 1.5.1. Confidentiality

- 1.5.1.1. Information relating to the examination, evaluation, comparison, and postqualification of Bids and recommendation for the signingof TPA, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until information on the signing of TPA is communicated to all Bidders unless it is specifically required by OREDA to do such disclosure as per the specific requirements.
- 1.5.1.2. Any attempt by a Bidder to influence OREDA's decisionto evaluate the Bids or signing of TPAmay result in the rejection of its Bid.
- 1.5.1.3. Notwithstanding ITB Clause1.5.1.2, from the time of Bid opening to the time of signing of TPA, if any Bidder wishes to contact OREDA on any matter related to the bidding process, it may do so in writing only.

#### 1.5.2. Clarification of Bids

- 1.5.2.1. To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of the Technical Bid and Price Bid, OREDA may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid. OREDA's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing only. No change in the substance of the Technical Bid or prices in the Price Bid shall besought, offered, or permitted. OREDA reserves all the rights to evaluate any such response received from the Bidder based on the clarification to be sought.
- 1.5.2.2. If a Bidder does not clarify its Bid by the date and time set in OREDA's request for clarification, such Bid shall be liable for rejection.

#### 1.5.3. Examination of Technical Bids

- 1.5.3.1. OREDA shall examine the Technical Bid to confirm that all documents and information requested in ITB Clause 1.3.3.2 for online submission and ITB Clause 1.3.3.3 for hardcopy submission have been provided assess the completeness of the Technical Bid.
- 1.5.3.2. OREDA shall confirm that all the requirements have been provided in the Technical Bid in all respect. If any of the documents or information is missing, the Bidshall be liable for rejection.

#### 1.5.4. Responsiveness of Technical Bid

- 1.5.4.1. OREDA's determination of a Technical Bid's responsiveness shall be strictly based on the contents of the Technical Bid, as mentioned in ITB Clause 1.3.3.2 and ITB Clause 1.3.3.3.
- 1.5.4.2. If a Bid is not responsive to the requirements of the RFP, it shall be liable for rejection by OREDA and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction of the material deviation, reservation, or omission.

#### 1.5.5. Qualification of the Bidder

- 1.5.5.1. OREDA shall determine its satisfaction during the evaluation of Technical Bids whether Bidders meet the qualifying requirements specified in Section 4 (QR).
- 1.5.5.2. The determination shall be based upon examining the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB Clause 1.3.3.
- 1.5.5.3. An affirmative determination shall be a pre-requisite for the opening and evaluation of a Bidder's Price Bid. A negative determination shall result in the disqualification of the Bid.

#### 1.5.6. Online Price Bid opening

- 1.5.6.1. The Price Bids shall be opened online after completing theTechnical Bids' evaluation by OREDA for all the responsive Bidders. OREDA shall open the online Price Bids on the E-procurement Website without disclosing the Bidders' name on the public domain. It shall be the responsibility of OREDA to keep the Bidders' nameconfidential for the Bids received against each project group as per the list provided in Annexure Clause 5.7
- 1.5.6.2. The Price Bidswill be evaluated based on the Bidders' quoted tariff for each project group. OREDA shall check the Price Bids' completeness as per the RFP instructions and the Price Bid specifically.
- 1.5.6.3. After evaluation of Price Bids by OREDA, a list of the Bidders will be prepared for each project group.
- 1.5.6.4. The selection of Successful Bidder, under this RFP, shall be as per ITB Clause 1.5.8.2.

#### 1.5.7. Online E-Reverse Auction

1.5.7.1. Pursuant to ITB Clause 1.5.6.3, the lowest quoted tariff in each projectgroup will be the ceiling tariff at the start of the E-Reverse Auction process. The Bidders shortlisted for the E-Reverse Auction can reduce their tariffs less than the tariff quoted in price bids to arrive at the TPA Tariff.

- 1.5.7.2. OREDA will publish the project group-wise schedule (date and time) to conduct the E-Reverse Auction at least twenty-four (24) hours before the event. It shall be the Bidders' responsibility to track the notices on E-Reverse Auction on OREDA Website and E-Procurement Website. In no case, OREDA shall be responsible in case the Bidder misses out on seeing any notices on E-Reverse Auction.
- 1.5.7.3. The shortlisted Bidders for E-Reverse Auction will be able to login into the E-procurement Website fifteen (15) minutes before the start time of the E-Reverse Auction.
  - a) The 'initial auction period' will be for a period of thirty (30) minutes.
  - b) An auto extension shall be made for another eight (8) minutes from the 'scheduled closing time of the initial auction period' if any Bidder quotes a tariff less than the lowest tariff in the auction floor during the last eight (8) minutes of the 'initial auction period'.
  - c) The auto extension of eight (8) minutes will be termed as 'auto extended auction period'.
    - i. For each Project Group, if any Bidder quotes a tariff less than the lowest tariff in the auction floor during the 'auto extended auction period', then a new auto extension shall be made for eight (8) minutes from the 'scheduled closing time of the extended auction period' and so on.
    - ii. For each Project Group, if any Bidder does not quote a tariff less than the lowest tariff in the auction floor during the 'auto extended auction period', then the E-Reverse Auction process will get automatically closed.
  - d) The minimum decrement value for tariff shall be in the multiples of 0.01 INR per kWh.
  - e) The Bidders can only quote any value lower than the lowest tariff quoted by any Bidder in a Project Group. However, at any stage, a Bidder cannot increase its tariff or match the lowest tariff. The Bidders can quote a valid bid by quoting a tariff lower than the lowest tariff quoted by any Bidders on a real-time basis on the auction floor.
  - f) The Bidder shall not have the option of changing the Project capacity or project groups while quoting the tariff during E-Reverse Auction.

## 1.5.8. Ranking of Bidder and preparation of list for selecting Successful Biddersafter the completion of online E-Reverse Auction

- 1.5.8.1. The list containing the ranking of the Biddersfor each project group will be prepared based on the following principle:
  - a) The Bidders will be ranked in the ascending order of the tariffs from L1, L2, L3, L4, and so on for the tariffs quoted at the end of the E-Reverse Auction.
- 1.5.8.2. OREDA shall prepare the final list of Successful Bidders for each project group

## 1.5.9. Ranking of Bidder and preparation of list for selecting Successful Bidderswhen no bidder has changed their quoted tariffs during reverse auction

- 1.5.9.1. The list containing the ranking of the Bidders for each project group will be prepared based on the following principle:
  - a) The Bidders will be ranked in the ascending order of the tariffs from L1, L2, L3, L4, and so on for the tariffs quoted in the Price Bid as per Bid Form 11..
- 1.5.9.2. OREDA shall prepare the final list of Successful Bidders for each project group

#### 1.5.10. Selection of Successful Bidders and allocation of capacity

- 1.5.10.1. OREDA has provisioned for allocation of approx. 6.5MW under the RFP. But this capacity may further increase or decrease as per theprovsions of Clause3.2.1.2.
- 1.5.10.2. The Successful Bidder(s)will be awarded thecapacity atTPATPATariff equal to the lowest tariff discovered at the end of the E-Reverse Auction for each project group as per Clause 1.5.8

- 1.5.10.3. When no bidder has changed their quoted tariff during the reverse auction in a project group, the Successful Bidder(s) will be awarded the capacity at TPATPATariff equal to the lowest Quoted Tariff in the Price Bid as per Bid Form 11 for that Project Group.
- 1.5.10.4. Work allocation to successful bidder(s), as applicable and necessary :
  - Successful Bidderquoting lowest Tariff in a project group.100% of capacity under concerned Project Group shall be awarded to such successful bidder.
- 1.5.10.4. If the successful bidder in a particular project group is unable (or refuses) to implement the project, 100% of capacity under concerned project group shall be awarded to the next bidder as per the ranking list prepared, provided that he matches the L1 tariff of the project group

#### 1.5.11. OREDA's right to accept any Bid, and to reject any or all Bids

1.5.11.1. OREDA reserves all the right to accept or reject any Bid or to annul the bidding process or reject all Bids at any time prior to the signing of TPATPA, without thereby incurring any liability to Bidders. In case of annulment, the Bids shall be liable for rejection online and the online copy of the Bid uploaded on the E-procurement Website shall be sent unopened to "Archive" and shall not be considered at all any further for evaluation.

### 1.6. Signing of Tripartite Agreement

#### 1.6.1. Award Criteria

1.6.1.1. The Successful Bidders shall be selected as per the allocation procedures mentioned in ITB Clause 1.5.

#### 1.6.2. Minimum Paid Up Share Capital to be Held by Project Promoter

1.6.2.1. No change in the controlling shareholding of the Bidding Company or Bidding Consortium shall be permitted from the date of submission of response to RfP till the execution of the TPATPA. However, in case the Project is being set up by a listed Company, this condition will not be applicable.

Following shall not be considered as change in shareholding as mentioned above:

- 1.6.2.2. - 1.6.2.4. 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## 3. Scope of Work (SOW)

Section 3 (SOW) contains about the Project, roles, and responsibilities of the individual Parties, Equipment requirements, Timelines, etc. that describe the SOW under the RFP.

### 3.1. About the Project

#### 3.1.1. Introduction

- 3.1.1.1. The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has a target of achieving 40 GW of rooftop solar pv installed capacity by 2022. Odisha has planned to adopt RESCO model for solar pv project installation across government buildings and institutions in Odisha. Under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha, it was decided to install solar rooftop projects for Government Institutions in RESCO model in the first phase of RESCO programs in Odisha.
- 3.1.1.2. This Scope of Work shall be for the selection of Solar Power Generators (SPG) for the development of RTS Projects on government buildings under RESCO model inOdisha. The Tripartite Agreement (TPA) shall form an integral part of the RFP.
- 3.1.1.3. As part of the Government of India's target to achieve a cumulative capacity of 100 GW solar photovoltaic installation by the year 2022, OREDA wishes to invite Bids for the selection of SPG in line with all the provisions of the RFP.
- 3.1.1.4. The energy generated from the Project shall be solely for the procurement of the beneficiary on payment of TPA Tariff as a result of the completion of E-reverse auction. The TPA Tariff shall be inclusive of all statutory taxes, duties, levies, cess etc. if applicable as on the last date of Bid submission. The TPA Tariff is a single levelized tariff for the Project and shall be applicable for all the 25 years of TPA period from the date of achieving the COD.
- 3.1.1.5. The bidders are free to choose to particiupate in the tender to set up the solar PV projects through any of the following modes. The bidders need to choose any one of the Implementing model during their submission.

Implementing ModelA (IM A):At Identified rooftop sites with Net Metering

Implementing Model B (IM B): At any where outside the identified sites (within same Discom's area) with Virtual Net Metering (Bidder is responsible to find its own land or roof area)

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#### 3.1.2. Objectives

The objectives of implementing this Project are to:

3.1.2.1. Support the institutions, departments to either develop the Project or to reduce their expenses towards electricity;

3.1.2.2. Support GRIDCO& Discom in meeting the solar RPO;

3.1.2.3. Reduce carbon footprint for a period of twenty-five (25) years; and

3.1.2.4. Generate local employment.

### 3.2. Roles and Responsibilities

#### 3.2.1. Roles and Responsibilities of the SPG

The SPG undertakes to be responsible solely, at SPG's own cost and risk, for the following

- 3.2.1.1. The SPG shall be responsible for the performance of the obligations mentioned in the RFP, any Addendum, any Corrigendum, any Clarification, TripartiteAgreement, etc.
- 3.2.1.2. OREDA has provisioned for allocation of ~6.5 MW under the RFP. But this capacity may further increase or decrease as per the available shadow free area with the beneficiary.

In case of IM A:

Within (30) days from the issuance of LOA, the successful bidder shall carry out detailed comprehensive site survey, access the available capacity at the concerned distribution transformer and analyze last twenty-four (24) Months of electricity bills received from procurer. And submit a complete assessment report within two (2) days from the completion of assessment.

Based on the assessment report of the successful bidder OREDA can revise the project capacity by taking consent from the beneficiary entities. And OREDA shall inform the revised capacity details to the successful bidder within 7 working days by issuing a formal letter.

In case of IM B:

Shall carry out detailed comprehensive site survey, and submit the copy of DPR to OREDA.

- 3.2.1.3. The SPG shall deploy a proven solar photovoltaic technology that has been developed anywhere in the World. However, the selection of SPG would be technology agnostic within solar photovoltaic technology and crystalline silicon or thin film or any other such technology, with or without trackers can be installed.
- 3.2.1.4. The Bidder shall ensure the use of solar photovoltaic modules and cells as per the ALMM (Approved List of Models & Manufacturers) issued by MNRE and revised from time to time.
- 3.2.1.5. The SPG shall be responsible for the designing, engineering, procuring, supplying, taking insurance, packing and forwarding, loading, transporting, unloading, safekeeping of Equipment, constructing, installing, erecting, testing, commissioning and achieving the SCOD of the Project. This shall be achieved in accordance with the Applicable Law, Prudent Utility Practices and all the terms and conditions of this Bidding Document consisting of the RFP, any Addendum, any Corrigendum, any Clarification, Power Purchase Agreement, and any amendment thereto.
- 3.2.1.6. The Successful Bidder shall ensure that the module mounting structures must be designed to be completely non-invasive (without any grouting/ chipping) on the rooftop space, in case of IM A. In this regard, an indicative design can be considered as per the Technical Specifications given in 5.4
- 3.2.1.7. SPG will be responsible for implementation and maintenance of the solar pv (list of sites are provided in Annexure Clause5.7, applicable for IM A) and for the use life of the project (25 years).
- 3.2.1.8. The SPG shall comply grid connectivity and other regulations as applicable.
- 3.2.1.9. The SPG is required to obtain necessary clearances as required for setting up the Project.
- 3.2.1.10. The SPG shall be responsible to put a notice board (at least 180cm x 120cm) at its Project Site main entrance prominently displaying the following message before declaration of COD.

- 3.2.1.11. Time is an essence in achieving the milestones and achieving the SCOD of the Project.
- 3.2.1.12. SPG shall be responsible for the execution of the Trpartite Agreement.
- 3.2.1.13. The SPG shall be responsible for owning the Project throughout the Term of TPA.
- 3.2.1.14. The SPG is required to maintain a minimum AC Capacity Utilization Factor (CUF) of 15% and a maximumCUF of 18.7%provided it is less than 90% of total electricity consumption (solar + discom electricity), as detailed in the TPA.
- 3.2.1.15. The SPGshall be responsible for directly coordinating and dealing with Discom, Government and other authorities in obtaining the Clearances as per the various provisions of the TPA.
- 3.2.1.16. The SPG shall be the Principal Employer of all the stakeholders directly/ indirectly involved in the Project.
- 3.2.1.17. The SPG shall be responsible for incurring all the costs and expenses including but not limited to all statutory charges, GST etc. related to setting up the Project.
- 3.2.1.18. The SPG shall be responsible for considering all the costs and expenses and its margin whatsoever to derive theTPA Tariff requirement for successfully developing and operating the Project for a period of twenty-five (25) years during the Term as per the TPA. In no case OREDA, GRIDCO, Department of Energy, or any Government shall be responsible for such a quotation of tariff by the Bidder.
- 3.2.1.19. The selected SPG shall commission the Project within six(06) months from date of issuance of LoA. The SPG may commission the Project during this period of six(06) months and the beneficiary obliged to purchase power from the commissioned Project at any time after the issuance of LoA.
- 3.2.1.20. The SPG shall be required to generate the solar energy as given in the terms and conditions of the TPA.
- 3.2.1.21. The SPG will ensure that all Equipment from the Project after their 'end of life' (when they become defective/ non-operational/ non-repairable) are handed over to the beneficiary and if they refuse, are disposed in accordance with the "e-waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011" notified by the Government and as revised and amended from time to time.
- 3.2.1.22. In case of IM A, The SPG shall be responsible for any water leakage or seepage due to project construction work on the roof during the installation of rooftop solar (RTS) plants and also during the O&M period of initial 3 years. In case of leakage during the above mentioned period, necessary repair by specialized agency approved by OREDA must be carried out by the Contractor immediately without any cost implications to OREDA, failing which PBG amount will be forfeited on pro rata basis for the respective building.

## 3.2.2. Roles and Responsibilities of OREDA, Discom, Department of Energy, Health & Family Welfare Department

- 3.2.2.1. OREDA shall be the nodal agency responsible for coordinating between various stakeholders for facilitation.
- 3.2.2.2. OREDA has created a Data Room which contains site wise details and past electricity bills for such site. The access to data room will be provided to bidders who pay/already paid the bid processing fee.
- 3.2.2.3. OREDA has obtained consent of Health & family Welfare Department to make payment to the power consumption bills centrally for DHHs & Govt. Medical colleges under this RFP. Relevant letter from the department is available in the Data Room.
- 3.2.2.4. The Appropriate Discom will provide connectivity through net-metering/Virtual Net Metering arrangement to the selected SPG. The Appropriate Discom will ensure "must-run" status to the Project installed under this program. OREDA shall act as facilitator to the beneficiaries in implementation of this program.

- 3.2.2.5. A duly constituted Committee of OREDA, and the Appropriate Discom officials along with officials of the Beneficiary will jointly physically inspect the Project in not more than three (10)Days from the date of receiving a written request from the SPG and certify successful commissioning of the Project.
- 3.2.2.6. OREDAshall ensure quality being maintained by the SPG based on the review of the Project Equipment, site visits and progress review and monitoring activities. In this regard, OREDA will develop a suitable monitoring mechanism, to analyze the progress and performance of the Project and reserves the right to carry out random checks to verify compliance of quality standards at any point of time with/ without prior notice.
- 3.2.2.7. OREDA shall be responsible for conducting bidding process. OREDA will conduct review meetings to monitor the progress and managing all aspects of the scheme.
- 3.2.2.8. OREDA shall be intermediary to facilitate the payment security and ensure timely payment to the selected SPG. OREDA will be one point of contact for the SPG for bill payments. OREDA shall make the payment on behalf of the respective beneficiaries as per the terms of the TPA. In this regard, OREDA shall deduct INR 0.10/kWh from the discovered TPA tariff towards Payment Security Facilitation Fee (PSFF) and make the payment to the SPG.
- 3.2.2.9. **Power to remove difficulties**: If there is need for any amendment to this tender/ program for better implementation or any relaxation is required in the norms due to operational problems, OREDA will be competent to make such amendments.

### 5.4. Technical standards& specifications

# Technical Parameter of photovoltaic solar module and various other components for use in grid connected solar power plants

All components of the PV plant shall be in accordance with technical specifications given in relevant IS/IEC Standards. The design and commissioning also shall be as per latest IEC/IS standards. The following are some of the technical measures required to ensure quality of the major components used in grid connected solar power Projects.

#### 1. PV Module Qualification

The PV modules used in the grid connected solar power Projects must qualify to the latest edition of any of the following IEC PV module qualification test or equivalent BIS standards.

Crystalline Silicon Solar Cell Modules IEC 61215

The PV modules used should be PID (Potential Induced Degradation) resistant and tested for PID as per IEC 62804.

In addition, PV modules must qualify to IEC 61730 for safety qualification testing @1000 V DC or higher. For the PV modules to be used in a highly corrosive atmosphere throughout their lifetime, they must qualify to IEC 61701.

The total solar PV array capacity should not be less than allocated capacity and should comprise of solar crystalline / Mono PERC modules of minimum 350 Wp and above wattage. Module capacity less than minimum 350 watts shall not be accepted.

#### 2. Module Mounting Structures

- Hot dip galvanized MS/ Pre-galvanized/ Anodized Aluminium or superior material (after approval from MNRE) mounting structures may be used formounting the modules/ panels/arrays. Each structure should have angle ofinclination as per the site conditions to take maximum insulation. However, toaccommodate more capacity the angle inclination may be reduced until theProject meets the specified performance ratio requirements.
- 2. The Mounting structure must be Non-invasive Ballast Type and any sort of penetration of the roof to be avoided. The design details are as follows:
  - i. The inclination of the module or tilt angleshould be within 10-15 degrees.
  - ii. The upper edge of the module must be covered with a windshield so as to avoid bulk air ingress below the module. Slight clearance must be provided on both edges (upper & lower) to allow air for cooling.
  - iii. An indicative drawing is shown at the end. .
- 3. The Mounting structure shall be so designed to withstand the speed for thewind zone of the location where a Project is proposed to be installed (forminimum wind speed of 200 km/hour). STAAD pro report of design calculations to be provided to the OREDA along with the project drawings & details. Suitable fastening arrangement that donot require drilling in rooftops should be adopted to secure the installationagainst the specific wind speed.
- 4. The mounting structure steel shall be as per latest IS 2062: 1992 andgalvanization of the mounting structure shall be in compliance of latest IS4759.
- 5. Structural material shall be corrosion resistant and electrolytically compatible with the materials used in the module frame, its fasteners, nuts and bolts. Aluminium structures also can be used, that can withstand the wind speed (for minimum wind speed of **200 km/hour**) of respective wind zone. Necessary protection towards rusting need to be provided either by coating or anodization.
- 6. The fasteners used should be made up of stainless steel. The structures shallbe designed to allow easy replacement of any module. The array structureshall be so designed that it will occupy minimum space without sacrificing theoutput from the SPV panels
- 7. Regarding civil structures the SPD need to take care of the load bearingcapacity of the roof and need arrange suitable structures based on the qualityof roof. The total load of the structure (when installed with PV modules) on theterrace should be less than 60 kg/m2.
- 8. The minimum clearance of the structure from the roof level should be 300 mm.

#### 3. Power Conditioners/ Inverters

The Power Conditioners/Inverters of the SPV power plants must conform to the latest edition of IEC/ equivalent BIS Standards as specified below:

The PCU/ inverter generated harmonics, flicker, DC injection limits, Voltage Range, Frequency Range and Anti-Islanding measures at the point of connection to the utility services should follow the latest CEA (Technical Standards for Connectivity Distribution Generation Resources) Guidelines.

The charge controller/ MPPT units environmental testing should qualify IEC 60068-2(1, 2, 14, 30)/Equivalent BIS standard. The junction boxes/ enclosures should be IP 65 (for outdoor)/ IP 54 (indoor) and as per IEC 529 specifications.

Anti-islanding (protecting against islanding of grid): The PCU/ inverter shall have anti-islanding protection in conformity to IEEE1547/UL 1741/IEC 621116 or equivalent BIS standard.

Built-in meter and data logger to monitor plant performance through existing BMS workstation shall be provided by Developer.

#### 4. Cables and connectors:

All cables and connectors for used for installation of solar field must be of solar grade which can withstand harsh environment conditions for 25 years and voltages as per latest IEC standards. (Note: IEC Standard for DC cables for PV systems is under development. It is recommended that in the interim, the Cables of 600-1800 Volts DC for outdoor installations should comply with the EN50618/ TUV 2pfg 1169/08/07 or equivalent IS for service life expectancy of 25 years)

#### 5. Other Sub-systems/Components

Other subsystems/components used in the SPV power plants (Cables, Connectors, Junction Boxes, ACDB,Surge Protection Devices, lightning arrestors etc.) must also conform to the relevant international/national Standards for Electrical Safety besides that for Quality required for ensuring Expected Service Life and Weather Resistance.

#### 6. Authorized Test Centres

The PV modules / Power Conditioners deployed in the power plants must have valid test certificates for their qualification as per above specified IEC/ BIS Standards by one of the NABL Accredited Test Centres in India. In case of module types/ equipment for which such Test facilities may not exist in India at present, test certificates from reputed ILAC Member body accredited Labs abroad will be acceptable.

#### 7. Warranty

• PV modules used in grid connected solar power plants must be warranted for peak output wattage, which should not be less than 90% at the end of 10 years and 80% at the end of 25 years.

- The modules shall be warranted for at least 10 years for failures due to material defects and workmanship.
- The mechanical structures, electrical works and overall workmanship of the grid solar power plants must be warranted for a minimum of 5 years.
- The Inverters/PCUs installed in the solar power plant must have a warranty for 5 years.

#### 8. Identification and Traceability

Each PV module used in any solar power Project must use a RF identification tag. The following information must be mentioned in the RFID used on each module (This can be inside or outside the laminate, but must be able to withstand harsh environmental conditions):

i. Name of the manufacturer of PV Module

- ii. Name of the Manufacturer of Solar cells
- iii. Month and year of the manufacture (separately for solar cells and module)
- iv. Country of origin (separately for solar cells and module)
- v. I-V curve for the module at Standard Test Condition (1000 W/m2, AM 1.5, 250C)
- vi. Wattage, Im, Vm and FF for the module
- vii. Unique Serial No. and Model No. of the module
- viii. Date and year of obtaining IEC PV module qualification certificate
- ix. Name of the test lab issuing IEC certificate
- x. Other relevant information on traceability of solar cells and module as per ISO 9000

Site owners would be required to maintain accessibility to the list of Module IDs along with the above parametric data for each module.

#### 9. Data Acquisition System / Project Monitoring

As part of the performance& project monitoring, the following shall be carried out:

a. The SPG shall maintain the list of Module IDs along with performance characteristic data for each module.

b. Weather Monitoring: The SPGs must install necessary equipment to continuously measure solar radiation on module plane, ambient temperature, wind speed and other weather parameters and simultaneously measure the generation of DC power as well as AC power generated from the plant. They will be required to submit this data to OREDA online through a real time data monitoring system

c. The SPGs shall provide access to OREDA or their authorized representatives for installing any additional monitoring equipment to facilitate on-line transfer of data for OREDA's data base

d. All data shall be made available as mentioned above for the entire duration of the TPA.


e. Generation Monitoring:Web-based monitoring should be available, which should not be machine dependent. The web-based monitoring should provide the same screens as available in the plant. Also, it should be possible to download reports from a remote web-client in PDF or Excel format

f. The plant data monitoring systems should be Open Platform Communications (OPC) compliant with standard DNP3 and modbus control interfaces over TCP/ IP having the provision to add protocol converters to implement custom and secure communications protocol standard for providing real time online data (including but not limited to irradiance, plant generation (instantaneous/daily/monthly/yearly), daily peak generation, temperature, wind speed etc.) to OREDA

#### 9. Safe Disposal of Solar PV Modules:

The SPG will ensure that all Solar PV modules from their plant after their 'end of life' (when they become defective/ non-operational/ non-repairable) are disposed in accordance with the "e-waste (Management and

Handling) Rules, 2011" notified by the Government and as revised and amended from time to time if the beneficiary refuses to take-over the solar assets post the TPA tenure of 25 years.
